Select the party section of your choice. **YOU MAY VOTE IN ONE PARTY SECTION ONLY; YOU CANNOT "SPLIT YOUR TICKET." IF YOU VOTE IN MORE THAN ONE PARTY SECTION, YOUR PARTISAN BALLOT WILL BE REJECTED.**

**DO NOT** vote for more candidates than indicated under each office title.

**WRITE-IN CANDIDATES:** To vote for a candidate whose name is not printed on the ballot, write or place the name of that candidate in the blank space provided and complete the arrow. Do not cast a write-in vote for a candidate whose name is already printed on the ballot for that office.

**CHECK BOTH SIDES OF BALLOT:** This ballot has two sides. Be certain to check the reverse side of the ballot.

**WHEN YOU HAVE COMPLETED VOTING:** Place the ballot in the secrecy sleeve so that votes cannot be seen and the numbered stub is visible. Return the ballot to the election official stationed at the tabulator. (If voting by absentee ballot, follow the instructions provided by the clerk for returning the ballot.)

**NOTE:** If you make a mistake, return your ballot to the election official and obtain a new ballot. Do not attempt to erase or correct any marks made in error.

**PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM FOR  
ELDERLY AND DISABLED MILLAGE QUESTION**

For the purpose of reauthorizing funding for a transportation system to be used primarily by elderly and disabled persons in Ingham County at the same combined total millage level previously approved by the voters in 2004 and 2006, shall the constitutional limitation upon the total amount of taxes which may be assessed in one (1) year upon all property within the County of Ingham, Michigan, be increased by up to 48/100 (.48) of one mill, \$.48 per thousand dollars of state taxable valuation for a period of five years (2011-2015) inclusive? (If approved and levied in full, this Millage will raise an estimated additional \$3,641,186 for the transportation system in the first calendar year of the levy based on state taxable valuation. If approved and levied, a portion of the millage may be disbursed to the Downtown Development Authorities of the Cities of East Lansing, Lansing, Leslie, Mason, Williamston, the Villages of Dansville and Stockbridge, and the Townships of Delhi, Lansing, Leroy, Meridian, and Vevay; the Tax Increment Finance Authorities of the Cities of Lansing and Williamston; the Local Development Finance Authorities of the Cities of East Lansing, Leslie and Mason; and the Brownfield Redevelopment Authorities of the County of Ingham, the Cities of East Lansing and Lansing, and the Township of Delhi; and the Ingham County Land Bank).

**CAPITAL AREA TRANSPORTATION AUTHORITY  
(CATA) MILLAGE PROPOSITION**

**CITY OF LANSING, CITY OF EAST LANSING,  
MERIDIAN TOWNSHIP, LANSING TOWNSHIP  
AND DELHI TOWNSHIP**

Shall the public transportation authority, the Capital Area Transportation Authority (CATA), for continued service, as provided for by Public Act 55 of 1963, as amended, effective with calendar year 2011 replace both (i) an existing tax levy of 2.22 mills (approved by the voters in 2004 and authorized through 2010 and currently in the amount of 2.1838 mills pursuant to reductions caused by the operation of the provisions of the Headlee Act) and (ii) an existing tax levy of 0.787 mills (approved by the voters in 2008 and authorized through 2012), with (i) a renewal of 2.9708 mills (that being \$2.9708 per thousand dollars of taxable value), and (ii) an increase of 0.0362 mills (that being \$0.0362 per thousand dollars of taxable value) on real and personal property located within the City of Lansing, City of East Lansing, Meridian Township, Lansing Township, and Delhi Township for the years 2011 through 2015 inclusive, which is a period of five years? The purpose of the increase of 0.0362 mills is to offset the reductions caused by the operation of the provisions of the Headlee Act. If approved and levied, this millage would generate approximately \$18,001,980 in its first year.

**LAW ENFORCEMENT AND POLICE PROTECTION  
MILLAGE PROPOSAL**

This Proposal will allow the Charter Township of Delhi to levy a millage for Law Enforcement and Police Protection services on all taxable property within the Charter Township of Delhi.

Shall the previously voted increase in the authorized charter millage for the Charter Township of Delhi which may be assessed on all taxable property as defined by law within said Township be increased by one and one-half (1 1/2) mills (\$1.50 per \$1,000.00 of taxable valuation) for a period of four (4) years, 2010 through 2013, inclusive, for the purpose of defraying, in whole or in part, the cost of law enforcement and police protection services, which levy is estimated to raise, in the first year of the levy, an estimated \$1,106,119.00?

**FIRE DEPARTMENT MILLAGE PROPOSAL**

This Proposal will allow the Charter Township of Delhi to levy a millage for Fire Department purposes on all taxable property within the Charter Township of Delhi.

Shall the previously voted increase in the authorized charter millage for the Charter Township of Delhi which may be assessed on all taxable property as defined by law within said Township be increased by one and one-half (1 1/2) mill (\$1.50 per \$1,000.00 of taxable valuation) for a period of four (4) years, 2010 through 2013, inclusive, for the purpose of defraying, in whole or in part, the cost of operating and maintaining the Delhi Charter Township Fire Department, which levy is estimated to raise, in the first year of the levy, an estimated \$1,106,119.00?

**DISTRICT LIBRARY**

**CAPITAL AREA DISTRICT LIBRARY RENEWAL**

Shall the Capital Area District Library renew its annual tax levy upon the taxable value of all property defined by law within the district of the Capital Area District Library in a renewal amount not to exceed 1.56 mills (\$1.56 per \$1,000 of taxable value) for a period of 4 years, 2010 through 2013 inclusive, to continue funding library operations?

The renewal amount of 1.56 mills is \$1.56 per thousand dollars of taxable value. If approved and levied in full, this millage renewal request of 1.56 mills will generate an estimated \$10,057,000 for the Capital Area District Library in the first calendar year. If approved and levied in full, a portion of the millage may be disbursed to the Downtown Development Authorities of the Cities of Lansing, Leslie, Mason, Williamston, the Villages of Dansville and Stockbridge, and the Townships of Delhi, Lansing, Leroy, and Vevay; the Tax Increment Finance Authorities of the Cities of Lansing and Williamston; the Local Development Finance Authorities of the Cities of Leslie and Mason; and the Brownfield Redevelopment Authorities of the County of Ingham, the City of Lansing, and the Township of Delhi; and the Ingham County Land Bank.
