## SENIOR SOFTBALL REMINDERS

1. Alcoholic beverages are not allowed on park grounds.
2. Teams must leave Valhalla Park immediately after the 9:30 game so the park may be locked.
3. There is a time limit of 1 hour & 10 minutes. All innings started will be completed.
4. Game time is forfeit time.
5. For the 50 & 60 divisions, batters begin with a one and one count with a Grace Foul Ball with two strikes.
6. The home team serves as the official scorekeeper, reporting the score to the umpire after each  $\frac{1}{2}$  inning.
7. A team leading by 10 runs after  $4\frac{1}{2}$  innings of play shall be declared the winner and that game is considered complete.
8. A limit of three (3) unassisted home runs will be allowed per team per game. Any over the fence unassisted home runs after the limit will be an out and base runners may not advance.
9. There will be a one game playoff at the conclusion of the regular season if there is a tie for first place.
10. All postponed games will be rescheduled. If a game is canceled due to weather, then all subsequent games are also canceled. Team managers will be notified by mail of the make-up date.
11. League champions will receive team and individual awards and the league runner-up will receive a team award.
12. Please consult your team manager for additional rules and regulations listed in both the A.S.A. rulebook and the Delhi Township parks & recreation by-laws.
13. Pitching Arc will remain 6 – 12 feet for senior softball leagues.
